



REPAIRS & DAMAGED EQUIPMENT PROCEDURE

The Edmonton Rowing Club recognizes that occasionally equipment needs repairs and that damages happen. We understand that no one intentionally damages equipment. If you are using club owned equipment and repairs are required or damages have occurred, it is your duty to promptly and properly record it. Never attempt to make major boat repairs on your own.

- STEP 1. Tell the Club Manager or Head Coach about the issue.
- STEP 2. If the Club Manager or Head Coach is not available, please fill out the ERC Equipment Repairs & Damage Report Form [HERE](#).

DID YOU KNOW?

Per Rowing Canada Aviron, if there is ever an incident during a rowing activity involving bodily injury or damage to property not owned by the Edmonton Rowing Club, a Rowing Canada Aviron Incident Report must be completed. If an RCA Incident Report is required, the Club Manager will contact you.
