To qualify you must be between 15 and 30 years old, and legally entitled to work in Canada.

Positions available:

Learn to Row Instructors – Adult and Youth Programs

Term of employment and time commitment – late April to late August 2022. You will work approximately 30 hours per week.

Duties:

Under the leadership of the Club Manager, summer Learn to Row instructors will be responsible to

- Instruct and coach Learn to Row and summer camp participants in the basics of rowing including sweeping, sculling, erging and indoor tank training.
- Demonstrate proper techniques for handling equipment, including rowing shells, oars, and safety equipment.
- Model and teach club rules, safety practices, traffic patterns and rowing terminology.
- Foster an enjoyable learning experience in a fun atmosphere.
- Support all ERC programs as required.
- Cultivate positive professional relationships with staff and members across all programs to achieve club goals.

Requirements:

- Self-starter who recognizes the importance of getting tasks done in a timely manner and possesses the ability to prioritize tasks.
- Hold or be willing to obtain RCA Learn to Row Coach or higher-level RCA coach certification (including associated NCCP training).
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, including fluency in verbal and written English.
- Proven coaching or teaching experience.
- Valid pleasure craft operator card and competency in driving a motorboat.

- Valid Standard First Aid with CPR C and AED certification.
- Clear criminal record check.

Wages:

Hourly rate will be based on experience and qualifications. The minimum rate is \$17/hour plus 4% vacation pay. If you complete your contract and obtain your Learn to Row Coach Certification, you will receive an additional \$1 per hour bonus at the end of your contract.

- Model and teach club rules, safety practices, traffic patterns and rowing terminology.
- Foster an enjoyable learning experience in a fun atmosphere.
